# EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR PROVISION OF EMERGENCY AND FIREFIGHTING SERVICES.

TotalEnergies EP Uganda B.V (Company), in its capacity as Operator of Contract Area (CA) 1 and License Area (LA) 2, in conjunction with its Joint Venture partner(s), invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from suitably qualified and experienced companies for the Call for Tender for the Provision of Emergency and Firefighting Services, as further described below.

### Scope of Work:

The scope of work comprises the provision of advanced rescue and fire response services, maintenance of firefighting equipment and emergency trainings, as detailed below, to be provided as and when required by Company and in accordance with the Contract at the worksite during Tilenga Project execution and production phase.

- (i) Provision of advanced rescue and firefighting response services on 24/7 basis, by providing fully equipped and maintained all-terrain drive emergency response vehicles with certified operators (drivers and firefighters).
- (ii) Development and coordination of emergency drills planning to be provided to Company for review and approval prior execution.
- (iii) Provision of preventive maintenance services for all Company mobile firefighting equipment and submission of a list of actions undertaken during preventive maintenance visits to be validated by Company.
- (iv) Provision of the basic firefighting (use of fire extinguishers, fire reels, fire wardens, etc.) and basic first aid for required Company personnel. The trainings content and program shall be validated by Company.

Interested parties may participate in this EOI as an entity or as an association of companies, where they shall (individually or collectively) demonstrate the following minimum requirements;

### Technical Experience:

1. Minimum of five (5) years' experience providing each of the following services:
  - a) Emergency responses services.
  - b) Emergency preparedness consultancy services.
  - c) Basic emergency training of general personnel.
2. Designed and/or implemented at least one (1) emergency response plan in an Oil and Gas operational installation.
3. Experience in supporting local suppliers or evidence of implementing capacity building initiatives.

In addition to the above-mentioned technical abilities, the interested parties shall demonstrate the following additional requirements:

- Experience in Quality, Health, Safety, Environment (QHSE) Management including policies, procedures and processes in compliance with applicable National and Industry standards.
- Suitably qualified and experienced personnel in sufficient numbers to support the scope of work.
- Financial capacity to deliver the services required.
- Evidence of current registration or in process of being registered on the National Supplier Database (NSD) managed by the Petroleum Authority of Uganda (PAU).

Please note that ARIBA will accept individual attachments and compressed folders (zip) not exceeding **150MB** per document upload. Documents may be split up to meet this system requirement.
