TotalEnergies EP Uganda (Company) the operator of Contract Area (CA) 1 and License Area (LA) 2, in conjunction with its Joint Venture partner (s) invites experienced and reputable contractors to express their interest in providing Maintenance and Inspection Engineering Services in respect of the development of the Tilenga Project, Lake Albert Basin, Republic of Uganda.

General Field Development Description:

The Tilenga oil and associated gas development is located in the Northern area of Lake Albert in Uganda and covers the fields in CA-1 block and the Northern part of LA-2 block (Tilenga Project).

The major development surface facilities include the following:

- Well pads (31) and the upstream gathering network
- The Industrial Area containing temporary facilities and the Central Processing Facility (CPF)
- The associated supporting infrastructure (camps, roads, aerodromes etc.)

The Maintenance and Inspection Engineering Service for the Project Phase

The Scope of Work covers the provision of Maintenance and Inspection Engineering Services during the Project phase. The activities will include but not limited to:

- Effective project management and planning
- Implementation of a Computerized Maintenance and Inspection Management System (CMIMS),
- Preparation of maintenance and inspection plans and procedures
- Performing Risk Based Inspection and RCM studies

- Identification of spares parts for critical equipment to meet production availability

The selected contractor will be able to demonstrate the following abilities

- Experience in the operational maintenance and inspection of industrial facilities
- Capability in the preparation of a maintenance regime for industrial facilities
- Proven track record in the execution of Risk Based Inspection Engineering and RCM activities.
- Operational knowledge related to spare parts identification
- Interface, Prioritization, and Planning competencies
- Availability of suitable employees, qualified and experienced in provision of the above said activities.

In addition to the above-mentioned technical capacity, the minimum requirements to participate in the Prequalification Process are

- Health Safety and Environment (HSE) Management system, Quality Policy and related procedures in compliance with local and international standards
- Be NSSF registered and with all required insurances for the vendor and its employees
- Adequate financial capacity to undertake the eventual contract
- Compliance to National and international laws and oil and gas international standards
- Commitment in compliance with statutory National Content requirements as stipulated in applicable law.
- Current registration to; or application to be registered to; the National Supplier Database of PAU.
